PRESCHOOL SERVICES

Speech and OT Therapy

Francis Parker partners with Functional Therapy to provide speech and occupational therapy services to students on campus. Functional Therapy will provide full evaluations to referred students at their clinic, and then therapy services during the school day, if needed. All services are billed and paid directly to Functional Therapy. Many insurance plans are accepted.

LOWER SCHOOL SERVICES

Speech and OT Therapy

Francis Parker partners with Functional Therapy to provide speech and occupational therapy services to students on campus. Functional Therapy will provide full evaluations to referred students at their clinic, and then therapy services during the school day, if needed. All services are billed and paid directly to Functional Therapy. Many insurance plans are accepted.

Reading Intervention

Kindergarten: As students begin learning to read, students who are referred to The Learning Center with early literacy difficulties, will receive targeted, small group instruction from a TLC specialist, as needed, to support classroom instruction. This service is provided at no additional cost.

First and Second Grade: Students who are not meeting grade level benchmark goals will receive reading intervention twice/week through targeted small group instruction provided by The Learning Center director. This service is provided at no additional cost.

Reading Remediation

First and Second Grade: Students who are not showing sufficient progress through small group intervention will be referred for 1:1 remediation. These sessions will take place over 6 week intervals with two 20 minute sessions occurring each week. After the end of six weeks, progress will be evaluated and next steps will be determined. This is a fee-based service of \$330/six week session.

Third and Fourth Grade: Students who require remediation of early literacy skills from previous years will be referred for 1:1 remediation. These sessions will focus on improving skills to move students closer to grade level benchmarks. These sessions are scheduled on a quarterly basis and meet once/week for 45 minutes. Additional sessions can be added as needed. This is a fee-based service of \$495/quarter.

English Language Support

Students who are dual language learners can receive 1:1 or small group instruction in conversational and survival oral English fluency alongside basic written communication skills. The number and frequency of sessions will be determined based on the student's individual needs. Please contact the TLC Director for rates.

MIDDLE SCHOOL SERVICES

Speech and OT Therapy

English Language Support

Students who are dual language learners can receive 1:1 or small group instruction in conversational and survival oral English fluency alongside basic written communication skills. The number and frequency of sessions will be determined based on the student's individual needs. Please contact the TLC Director for rates.

1:1 and Small Group Academic Support

These are weekly sessions designed to help students with planning, time management, organization, task-initiation, goal-setting, and problem-solving for all school assignments with an emphasis on personal areas of academic challenge. Small groups are based on grade-level. These sessions are scheduled on a quarterly basis and meet once/week for 45 minutes. Additional sessions can be added as needed. This is a fee-based service of \$495/quarter for 1:1 support and \$375/quarter for small group support.

Well-Organized Wyverns

This is our executive function coaching service. Students will work with their coach on skills including goal setting, time management, planning, and prioritization. Students will develop a personalized organizational system that works for their needs, build metacognition skills, and improve working memory. This is a fee-based service that is offered daily or twice/week. Sessions are approximately 15 minutes each. Quarterly fee is \$375 for daily coaching and \$200 for twice/week coaching.

1:1 Math Tutoring

Individualized tutoring sessions are offered to help students succeed with current skills and concepts as well as re-teaching previous skills, as needed. This is a fee-based service of \$495/quarter.

Stop for Success

Middle School students can elect to check-in with TLC academic support specialists every day at dismissal to ensure they are up to date on long term assignments and upcoming projects or assessments. This service is provided at no additional cost.

Learning Lounge

Students in grades 4-8 can stay after school until 5:30 daily for supervised time to work on assignments and receive academic and organizational assistance. Students should bring any unfinished work and a book to read. This is a fee-based service of \$24/day.

HIGH SCHOOL SERVICES

1:1 Academic Support

These are weekly sessions designed to help students with planning, time management, organization, task-initiation, goal-setting, and problem-solving for all school assignments with an emphasis on personal areas of academic challenge. These sessions are scheduled on a quarterly basis and meet once/week for 45 minutes. Additional sessions can be added as needed. This is a fee-based service of \$495/quarter.

Well-Organized Wyverns

This is our executive function coaching service. Students will work with their coach on skills including goal setting, time management, planning, and prioritization. Students will develop a personalized organizational system that works for their needs, build metacognition skills, and improve working memory. This is a fee-based service that is offered twice/week for high school students. Sessions are approximately 15 minutes each. Quarterly fee is \$200.

1:1 Math and Science Tutoring

Individualized tutoring sessions are offered to help students succeed with current skills and concepts as well as re-teaching previous skills, as needed. This is a fee-based service of \$495/quarter.

1:1 or Small Group World Language Tutoring

Individualized tutoring sessions for Spanish and Chinese are offered to help students succeed with current skills and concepts as well as re-teaching previous skills, as needed. This is a fee-based service of \$495/quarter for 1:1 tutoring or \$375 for small group tutoring.

Homework Hall

Academic and organizational assistance is provided on an as-needed basis to students from 3:30 until 5:00 p.m., Monday - Thursday. Students must register in advance in The Learning Center. Drop-in requests are not guaranteed. This is a fee-based service of \$24/day.
